CBMS PTO Discretionary Grant Guidelines

- 1. The PTO mission, guiding principles, priorities and budget capacity will guide grant allocation decisions for the year.
- 2. Requests for furniture and capital items are generally not eligible.
- 3. Discretionary grants are intended to provide activities, services and items beyond those typically provided for in the annual school budget.
- 4. Collaborative projects and pilot projects that can be replicated are encouraged.
- 5. Staff and caregivers are eligible to apply for discretionary grants, however teachers will be given preference.
- 6. Discretionary grants will be evaluated twice a year. Deadlines to file are November 1st and May 1st of the current year. Team applications are accepted at any time, as funds allow.
- 7. Items funded by the PTO will become the property of CBMS, not of individuals.
- 8. When possible, items and activities will be identified as having been donated or funded by the CBMS PTO.
- 9. The PTO Grant Committee or PTO Board of Directors will oversee and initiate the allocation process each year.
- 10. All grant recipients are required to submit an online follow-up report found at the button below upon completion of their project.
